Miller Elementary School has a milk/juice company where students are able to purchase a small milk ( 250 ml , white or chocolate) or juice box for \$0.75.

Many families find that a milk card is easier to use. Each card sells for $\$ 10.00$ and will buy 15 drinks. Cards are kept at school and hole punched when used. When all punches on the card are used, a note will be sent home so that you may purchase another.

If you wish your child to have milk and not juice with his/her card, please write a note and we will mark this down for reference. Throughout the year, the Miller Milk Company has several draws to promote milk.
