Miller Milk Company Milk Cards

Milk cards can be purchased from the office or the Milk Company for \$10.00 (13 punches) or drinks bought individually for \$0.75. Cards are kept at school and hole punched when used. These cards are sent home with a note when used up. White and chocolate milk are available as well as SunRype fruit juices.

Before and After School

We ask that city students not arrive until 8:45 a.m. or later. There will be a supervisor outside at 8:30 a.m. to monitor bus arrivals. All students must go home following classes. If students want to play, they must be supervised by parents.

Little Library vs Big Library

Miller Elementary continues to house a Little Library by the front door with a handy take a book, leave a book exchange. Please remember this is not a place to drop off school library books that have been signed out. This can cause our valuable books to be damaged.

School Doors

Miller School's door will be locked at 9:15 a.m. If you need to pick up your child or they are coming back from lunch or an appointment, please use the main school door on 6th Ave. West.



School Closure

Schools remain open with staff in attendance for those students who are able to attend if a bus route, several bus routes, or all routes do not run, unless authorized by the Director.

In the event of a school power or water emergency, a closure may be announced. School closures will be broadcast on CJGX 94. A fan out telephone system will be used to contact parents. In the event that a school closure takes place during the school day, parents or billets will be contacted by phone.

If p.m. bus routes are cancelled the billets or parents of bus students will be called.
