### 2. Treasurers Report

- Chequing- \$8, 156.18, Savings \$1, 504.94
- Expenses- \$1, 512.93

### 3. Principals Report

- BBQ has arrived
- Melville principals meet Friday to discuss School Cash and concerns with extra fees; Jodi Alexander will work on School Cash launch on prep days at the end of January
- Ms. Molaro, Mrs. Glowa, and SCC are taking over Telemiracle fundraising with lots of new ideas: hotdog sale, candy jar guesses, principal for a day, hat day, buy a period of tech time
- Tentative date for next SCC hot lunch is Thursday, March 30<sup>th</sup>; J. Sies checked into pizza from Chicken Chef and a large pizza (8 slices) is \$23 and they'd need about 1 week notice; would sell for about \$5; about 5 students who may not be able to purchase and between SCC, school, donations we will ensure everyone who wants hot lunch receives it; K. Frick and K. Johnson can help on hot lunch day
- School skating emails with info and dates went out to families; 2 dates for each grade; school is ensuring all students have skates/helmets; families are welcome to attend
- Winterruption- tentative date for February 16<sup>th</sup> or 17<sup>th</sup> starting after lunch for about 1.5 hours; option for skating at Kinsmen ODR if parents take their children; SCC will sponsor hot chocolate
- New playground equipment
  - Hoping for new equipment install this year
  - We have \$10,000 to go towards new equipment
  - Options for new merry-go-round looked into with price being \$26,000, \$4000 freight, and pay to install
  - Possible fundraiser ideas: gift card bouquet with gift cards purchased by SCC if done this spring or possibly donated if done in the fall; talk to other SCCs about their fundraising ideas
  - Grants: Cornerstone Credit Union grant- application closed for 2022, C. Lechner will stop in at CCU to ask about application; brainstorm other grant/donation ideas
  - Loan from school division (min \$500, max \$100, 000) with 25% down payment, paid back over 5 years with 20% annual payment on principal amount, unsure if grants can be used to pay it back, members mutually agreed this would be a last resort right now.
