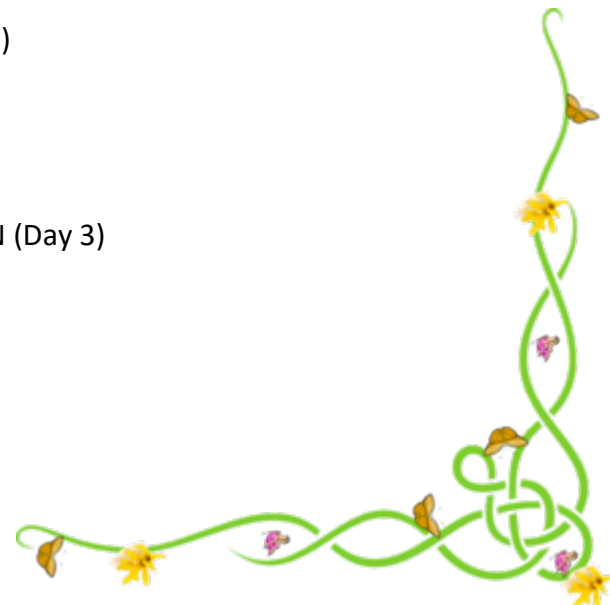


Dates/Events to Remember
