Miller Milk Company Milk Cards

School Supply/Agenda

Miller School provides their students with all the basic school supplies. There will be a one-time nominal fee at the beginning of each school year to cover the cost of the school agenda and supplies. These fees are due when your child starts school.

Kindergarten = Agenda (\$10.00) + Supply Fee (\$25.00) = \$35.00 Grades 1-6 = Agenda (\$10.00) + Supply Fee (\$35.00) = \$45.00

Agendas are a vital tool for communication. Teachers will use them to send home important information from the school and we ask parents to do the same. Please use your child's agenda to let their teacher know if your child will be absent, late, picked up early, picked up vs taking the bus, or any other important information that needs to be passed along.
