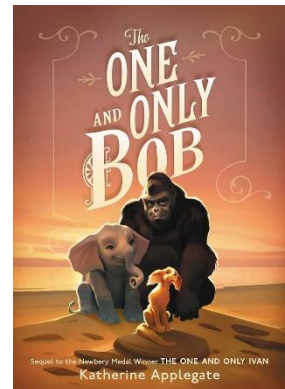
Report Cards and Student Led Conferences (Parent/Teacher Interviews)

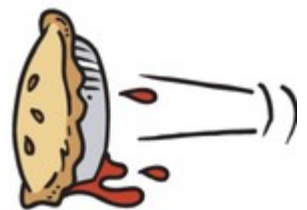
Thanks to all of the participation and generous donations from our Miller families, we were able to raise a grand total of...
