Buses will leave promptly at 9:00 am so please ensure your child is at the school by 8:45 am.

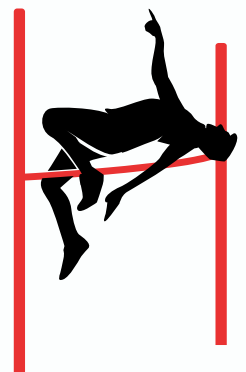
Events begin around 9:30 and families are welcome to attend.

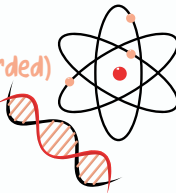

We ask that you provide these items for your children in their lunches if they are needed. Any donations of these items would be greatly appreciated!

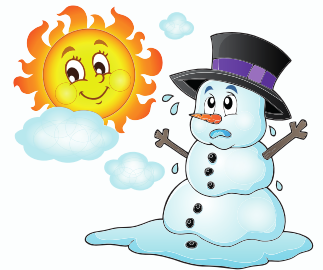

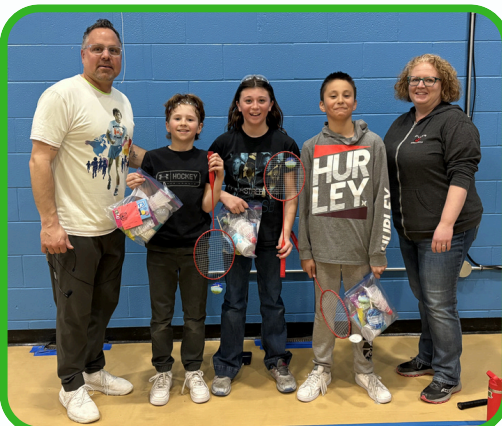
