## Health Concerns

This year at Miller Elementary we have a few students with nut allergies; one in Grade 1/2, one in Grade 2/3 and one in Grade 4/5. We ask that all students/rooms be nut conscious and that students in Mrs. Schick and Mrs. Boake's rooms avoid sending food with nuts if possible. We also ask that perfume and/or strong lotions not be used as many teachers and students have adverse reactions to scents.

## School Supplies/Agenda Fees

Miller School provides their students with all the basic school supplies. There will be a one-time nominal fee at the beginning of each school year to cover the cost of the school agenda and supplies. These fees are due when your child starts school.



Kindergarten (No Agenda) = \$35.00

Grades 1-6 = Agenda (\$10.00) + Supply Fee (\$35.00) = \$45.00



Agendas are a vital tool for communication. Teachers use them to send home important information from the school and we ask parents to do the same. Please use your child's agenda to let their teacher know if your child will be absent, late, picked up early, picked up vs taking the bus, or any other important information that needs to be passed along.

## Milk Company

Milk cards can be purchased from the office or the Milk Company for \$10.00 (11 punches) or drinks bought individually for \$1.00.



Milk cards are kept at school and hole punched when used. These cards are sent home with a note when used up. White and chocolate milk are available as well as fruit juice boxes.

### School Closure

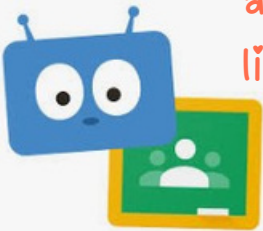
